- Enthusiasm, willingness to work, flexibility, and be adaptable to the changing priorities.

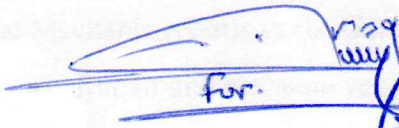
